Junior Club Rules

Hampset Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect, are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Adrian Jeffrey, Youth Team Manager.

As a junior member of Hampset Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents.
- Junior members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Junior members should inform their coach or team manager as soon as possible if unavailable for match through illness or similar reason.
- Junior members must wear suitable kit (Helmet, box and gloves for batting and wicket keeping when playing with a hard ball) for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Junior members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
